History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

The Monroe County records show that a surveyor was at this corner in March of 1898 and set a post at an old corner location. Schroeder and/or LaRue were at this corner in November and December of 1899 and found the corner to be in. Fred Holden shows this corner on his Plat of Home Cemetery in April of 1934.

Description of corner evidence found:

This corner falls in an old cemetery and was set so as to best fit the old accepted occupation, cemetery deeds, and the old cemetery plat. While setting the Harrison. I also dug a trench, but found no evidence of the old corner. Mr. Currier. the old caretaker. was a witness.
