History of original corner establishment:

No subsequent history of monument perpetuation since the original U.S. Government Survey.

Description of corner evidence found:

This corner was established at the intersection of old fences. This location agrees well with measurements one mile West and  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile East, therefore, the existing corner location was considered the best evidence as to the proper location of this corner, especially after taking into account the extremely hilly and rugged terrain.
