There is no history of any survey in this section, but judging from the field evidence in Section 26, it is the opinion of this surveyor that Section 26 was subdivided in an irregular fashion at an unknown date. I believe that the old Cl/4 was set so that it was the same distance from the Nl/4 as it was from the S1/4, and the same distance from the E1/4 as it was from the W1/4. I set the corner by intersecting the N-S1/4 line with the E-W1/4 line fence. This fits very well the irregular method stated above.


