Description of corner evidence found:

Set corner in line with fence to the south and in line with the N_{4}^{1} and NE corners of Section 1. This fits Holden's distance to the W_{4}^{1} corner of Sec. 36, T16N-R1W very well. Also, Mr. Witt, and older farmer in this same area, told me that when Eagle Drive was put through many years ago, that the road was to be all South of the Town Line because the owner at the time needed the money and therefore willing to have the roadway on his property. This testimony would go along with our corner location assuming it was a three road road when originally laid out.
