Accepted fence corner as the best available evidence. This corner fits Holden's distance to the NW corner of Section 4 within $2'\pm$. It is approximately $40'\pm$ short of Holden's distance to the SW corner of Section 4, however, can be easily understood as there are three slopes of 30° or greater between the SW and W½ corners. Corner falls on the north side of a $30^{\circ}+$ slope.
