Description of corner evidence found: To the Northwest I found what I believe to be an original Bearing Tree. The old stump was very rotted and easily broke apart. It was hard to judge its size considering its condition, but it was smaller than expected. However, considering the steep slope and sandy stoney ground, one can assume that an oak in this location would grow slower than normal. Set as such, this corner fits the road for alignment to the South and fits the original distance to the South to the 4 corner (meas. = 2638.41, Rec. = 2640). The existing line fence to the East at the W/16NW corner splits this 1/2 mile distance perfectly. This corner also fits the original distance for two miles to the East (meas. = 10532.03 Rec. = 10525.68).
