


The North line of Section 7 assumed S 88°33'31" E

I searched for a monument at the East quarter corner of Section 7, TI6N—R4W and found nothing. No Burr Oak bearing trees remain, quarter corner falls in an active agricultural area. A Harrison monument was set equidistant from the northeast corner and the southeast corner in line with the fences to the North and to the South. Set monument 20"7- below surface.


