History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

O.R. Dahl found the original corner in November of 1868 as did Fred Holden in June of 1910.

Description of corner evidence found:

I set the corner on line between the existing Harrisons at the SW and SE corners of Section 17, and on line with an old fence to the South. To the East I measure 2607.90 feet which is very close to Dahl's 1868 distance of 2607.66 feet. To the West I measure 2636.38 feet which is very close to Holden's 1910 distance of 2636.04 feet. This location also seems to line up fairly well with an old line fence further to the North across the valley.
