

History of original corner establishment:

H. Schroeder commenced a highway survey at this corner in Sept. of 1884.

Description of corner evidence found:

Accepted the occupied fence corner as the best available evidence. The corner as set fits overall conditions except for the closing distance to the West. The terrain to the West is very rugged terrain, thus accounting for the shortage & severe error in the original survey. An occupied forty fence to the West only measures 1291 feet which shows that this shortage was also found when the section to the South was subdivided.
