Reverse R 4W Fourth Principal Meridian, and I reestablished said corner according to the Wisconsin Description of corner evidence found: Statutes as shown and described hereon. An old local resident, Claude Williams, age 68, described the location Dated this 15 day of Jan 1976. of a stone that had been there for over 60 years. We could not find the stone, but placed a 14" iron bar in the described spot. We did find a small stone with an "x" on it at the fence corner. It did not appear Side to be a stoneset by a surveyor, so we placed it by the iron bar. Mr. County Surveyor Williams' description sounded accurate and trustworthy, especially since the corner missed the fences and fell into his occupied lands.
