Furthermore, I could not determine from his field notes whether he had set a corner here or even tied in this corner to his survey, which led me to believe that his corner tie was only a computed location. It's my opinion then, that the existing field conditions, which is the best available evidence at this corner, should determine the location of this corner. I set the corner at the inersection of the North-South and East-West fences.
