History of original corner establishment:

No subsequent history of monument perpetuation since the original U.S. Government Survey, except for reference to this corner in a plat of survey by J. Carroll. See explanation below.

Description of corner evidence found:

This corner was established half-way and on line between a Harrison at the NE corner of Sec. 27 and the NW corner of Sec. 27 as I have established it. This location does not agree with the occupied fence corner at this location. The established corner falls approximately 55.3' North and 170.3' East of the occupied corner. there are several reasons I didn't use the occupied corner. First, using the occupied corner produced a 1°30' kink in the section line and produced distances to the East and West far to long and short, respectively. A

REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR, S-1266 nearby landower residing in the vicinity of this corner location and having knowledge of the area, told me personally that fences in this area had been moved, perhaps considerably, by a former landowner.
