History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

March 17, 1886 : the northeast corner was presumably used by W. Kenyon for a survey in Section 7. April 28, 1893 : the northeast corner was used by Schroeder for a survey in Section 5. 1904: Fred Holden used this corner for several surveys as follows: Section 6 on May 20 and 21; Section 7 on August 31 and September 1; and Section 8 on September 2. He noted bearing trees standing and "add stake" Oct 172: fence corner was tied to by Fred Zietlow as a check Description of corner evidence found: for setting of East Quarter corner of Section 6 and

the South Quarter corner of Section 5.

The remains of the fence corner were used as the best evidence of the location of this corner. The distances north and east match Zietlows and also fit a prorated position very well.
