History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

Surveyor Keach surveyed north from S1/4 corner to N1/4 corner and set a random C1/4 on N-S 1/4 line in 1909. Surveyor Ray Hurlburt ran between E1/4 and W1/4 corners and set true C1/4 corner in 1959 based on Keach's random C1/4 corner. Surveyor Hurlburt also staked a parcel for Zielsdorf at the time. Hurlburt surveyed for Floyd Brown in 1966 and checked into the C1/4 corner. He adjusted some stakes set earlier.

Surveyor Ken Carlson could not find Hurlburt's C1/4 corner and reset the C1/4 corner from stakes found from Zielsdorf and Brown surveys.

The distance between the current monuments at the SE and SW corners of Section 2 is 5106.76 feet as measured by GPS. This compares with the original government survey distance of 79 chains, 5215 feet.

Th. S1/4 was set at the intersection of a straight line connecting the monuments at the SE and SW corners of Section 2 with the extension of a line from the monuments at the N1/4 corner through the C1/4 corner. The resulting intersection position is 6.65' west of splitting the distance between existing SE and SW corner monuments.
