Description of corner evidence found:

After surveying out Section 13, I set the corner at a location that best fits the existing monuments and occupation in Section 13. The old railroad map calls for the corner being 141 'South of the track centerline, and it is. I measure 2633.15' to the SW of Section 13, and the railroad map calls for 2636'.I measure 1316.82' to the S1/16SE of Section 13, and the railroad South of the corner is a 19" Black Oak with wire running through it. This oak is 1.6' East of the existing fence. Therefore the corner matches the

Deputy County Surveyor map calls for 1316'. This corner is 1.5' East of the fence, but 12.5' to the older occupation.
