Justice Center/Courthouse/Jail:

- -We replaced 2 large and 1 small window this month.
- -We have had a few problems with water valve switches. 3 of them have needed the wires repaired this month.
- -Jon from Kueny architects has some plans for the Courthouse to review. I should have them for our meeting.

Citizens Bank Building (Executive Building)/Clinic Building:

- -We have completed the construction of 2 more offices in the Executive building.
- -We will be building more walls to improve the basement to prepare for occupancy
- -We currently have an advertisement in the paper for remodel of the Clinic building.
- -We completed moving into the Executive building. We have titled that building the executive building.

Museum:

-We are preparing to cover the water damaged wall and apply a fresh coat of paint. We believe that our leak finally has been corrected.

Rolling Hills:
