## MONROE COUNTY FAIR HOUSING PROCLAMATION

1 2 3	WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Act, enacted on April 11, 1968, enshrined into federal law the goal of eliminating racial segregation and ending housing discrimination in the United States; and
4 5 6 7	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination in housing based on race, color, religion, sex, familial status, national origin, and disability, and commits recipients of federal funding to affirmatively further fair housing in their communities; and
8 9 10	WHEREAS, Monroe County is committed to the mission and intent of Congress to provide fair and equal housing opportunities for all; and
11 12 13	WHEREAS, our social fabric, the economy, health, and environment are strengthened in diverse, inclusive communities; and
14 15 16	WHEREAS, more than fifty years after the passage of the Fair Housing Act, discrimination persists, and many communities remain segregated; and
17 18 19	WHEREAS, acts of housing discrimination and barriers to equal housing opportunity are repugnant to a common sense of decency and fairness.
20 21 22 23	<b>NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED</b> that Monroe County Board of Supervisors proclaims its commitment to Fair Housing in regards to the Federal Fair Housing Act of 1968 to ensure there is equal access to housing for every member in the community; and
24 25 26 27	<b>FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED</b> that the Monroe County Clerk shall send copies of this proclamation to the Wisconsin Department of Administration, Division of Energy, Housing and Community Resources.
