1 2 3 4 5	WHEREAS:	Monroe County administers the Child Support Enforcement Program on behalf of the state, providing services to Monroe County residents including paternity establishment, obtaining child support and health insurance orders for children, and enforcing and modifying those orders; and
6 7 8	WHEREAS:	Our children's well-being, economic security and success in life are enhanced by parents who provide financial and emotional support; and
9 10 11	WHEREAS:	County child support agencies collected \$935 Million in child support during 2019 and established 98,405 health insurance orders for Wisconsin children; and
