This location fits within 4 feet of the original notes to the south, but is about 1^1_2 chains short to the W^1_4 of Section 9. I did not prorate this corner as I feel the original surveyors had problems in Section 9 and did not want to carry it into the sections to the south. Also, Holden shows a distance along the east side of section 17 of 5306.40 finding no shortage on the line running north between sections 16 and 17.
