of October 1985, I found (evidence) (no evidence) of the corner of Section 11, T^{18} N, R $\frac{4}{}$ W, Fourth Principal Meridian, and I reestablished said corner according to the Wisconsin Description of corner evidence found: Statutes as shown and described hereon. I set the corner at a computed location: on line with the fence to the North, Dated this 16th day of Nov. 1985. on line with the fence along the South line of the SW1/4-SE1/4 of Section 3, and William C.
