Highlighted Projects and Activities by Jarrod Roll, Hannah Scholze, and Volunteers

- Facilitated the MCHS Board meeting for the items regarding the proposed amendments to the MCHS bylaws and the suggested transfer of ownership of the MCHS artifact collection to LHR
- Drafted end of year report for the Wegner Grotto County Park which reports finances, visitation, and preservation activities during 2020
- Finalized design of the large exhibit materials storage shelves for the Court Record Room, acquired materials and fabricated
- Began discussions with key Monroe County teachers to about potential LHR distance programming opportunities for their students this spring
- Participated in STEPS webinar to learn more about the program and evaluate if it is right for LHR
- Met with a key translator at the Ft. McCoy Refugee Resettlement Center in 1980 to interview her and scan letters in her possession
- Participated in a webinar about distanced educational programming provided by historical organizations during the pandemic
- Set up home-office during mandatory quarantine

Agriculture Program Highlights February 6, 2021 through March 5, 2021

The Ag Agent has continued to respond to people via phone calls, e-mails and press releases to help address various needs along with a few farm visits following biosecurity protocols. Common questions that have been addressed over the past month were: more beef cattle rations, implant management strategies, crops and soils inputs questions for next year's season, land rent, real estate sales procedures, bunker silo questions and a few more greenhouse management questions.

The Ag related webinars continue. Of those I am directly part of, our third and fourth UW beef webinar were held featuring Dr. Dan Thomsen, from Iowa State who presented information on managing new feeder cattle on arrival at the feedlot, and Dr. Dorte Dopfer, UW Madison College of Vet Medicine who discussed digital dermatitis (hairy heal warts in beef cattle. We continue to receive positive feedback on these sessions from several participants. They have been well attended.

We held the annual Hops Winter conference on February 27th in cooperation with the Minnesota hops growers since it was virtual. We had over 80 people attend the program live.

The Ag Agent continues to work towards conducting summer field plots.

The Ag Agent was a guest speaker for the Livestock Marketing course at UW Platteville.

Agents 4 Change w/Monroe County Safe Community Coalition

Jr. Leaders

The Jr. Leaders group is coming back online. They were finally able to have their snow day on the 27th. The meeting was exciting with everyone together. The youth are eager to get planning for the day camps and other activities that will be happening this summer. They are also excited about figuring out a plan to make the ice cream stand at fair work.

ZOOMerang Trivia Nights

The February ZOOMerangs were very popular. There were 9 families that participated in the two trivia nights. the kids asked to make the March meetings Trivia nights too. March 11 will be arts and culture. March 25 will be general trivia, maybe set up more like a Jeopardy board to cover many topics at once.

Project Saturday

The first county wide project meeting is now being planned for March 6, 2021. We have 22 youth and 4 adults signed up in one of 4 projects. The projects lined up is sewing pillowcases, face masks, and hats; Leather Crafting, Glass etching and, cake/cookie decorating. Community Stakeholder Meeting

On February 16th I participated in the community stakeholder meeting to help determine the top five priorities for our county which are: mental health, mental health services, children in poverty, drug and alcohol abuse, and affordable housing.

Monroe County Nutrition Coalition

I will be partnering with WIC and Fit Families and the Sparta Chamber of Commerce for the Bike Expo and Edible Garden project. We are going to have our first meeting soon. Great Rivers Hub is going to hire a bilingual community service worker for our county who will focus on Type 2 diabetes and social determinants of health needs.

Monroe County Mental Health Coalition

Members provided updates and Mental Health month was discussed. The coalition is planning to have a virtual event and a speaker. The virtual walk committee met in February. We reviewed the flyer and registration form that we have been working on and assigned tasks to work on for the next meeting (radio PSA, news release, etc.).

HEAL (Healthy Eating, Active Living)

The Aging Mastery Program participants shared some positive feedback regarding the class. Here's a few examples: "It was a wonderful, enriching, beneficial program. I'm so happy that I was selected to participate." "I enjoyed all the sessions and the presenters. With every presenter I learned something new and will apply that in my life." I am in the fifth week of the "Achieving the Extension Mission Through Volunteers" class. This week we are learning about volunteer training, recognition, and coaching. We are also creating a comprehensive plan for supporting a volunteer system. The class will end on March 19th. During part of the HEAL Huddle meeting the spotlight was on my programming and partnerships.

FoodWise

On Monday, March 1st I had my first after school nutrition lesson with the WIN after school program

students at Herrman elementary. The lesson went very well, and the students enjoyed it. I will be doing lessons every Monday and Wednesday for four weeks. On Wednesdays, the students get to do a taste test of a healthy snack. This Thursday, March 4th I am facilitating a virtual family cooking class event where we will prepare healthy mini pizzas. Nineteen families registered for this event! Also, on March 4th the after-school coordinators and I are meeting with Nicole Vik from the Monroe County Herald to discuss our partnership.

StrongBodies

Our current session continues to go well, and it will end on Wednesday, March 24th. Last month we had Beth Olson, a nutrition specialist, speak to the participants about heart health.

Health Matters Newspaper Column

I submitted two articles to the newspaper in February. The first article was about a UW-Madison Division of Extension campaign encouraging people to check their free credit reports. The second article discussed heavy metals in baby foods, and it provided several steps parents can take to reduce the risk of exposure.

Natural Resources Conservation Service Report

Beginning March 2nd, the NRCS staff is adjusting to new office level staffing restrictions. Per our national level, all offices are allowed a maximum of 25% staff in the building. With covid rates so low in our areas, we are waiting for a possibility of a variance to this policy, but can do nothing locally to make that change. We do have proper equipment for teleworking, but are anxious to be fully in the office again.

We are wrapping up the first round of Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) contracting. In Monroe County we are obligating 19 contracts including practices such as dams, diversions, waterways, pollinator plantings, grazing systems, forestry practices and hoop houses. We are also obligating 10 RCPP contracts for streambank projects. Next sign-up deadline is May 21, 2021.

Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) just wrapped up obligating renewals, only one was funded in Monroe County, but only had 2 eligible.

Next CSP signup deadline has been announced as March 26, 2021.

Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) general deadline has been extended indefinitely due to the new administration reviewing the program details. No further details yet. The Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP) is on-going.

- <u>Program Participation</u> Spoke to the Kiwanis Club, Wisconsin Land & Water Conference, and Wisconsin Initiative on Climate Change Impacts (WICCI), NRCS 580 team, PL566 Meeting, EPA Kickapoo Watershed Project, and State Dept. of Health.
- <u>Climate Change Task Force</u> Hosted state and federal legislatures to discuss Governors proposed budget relative to the CCTF objectives; only one state rep participated. Updates provided: Alison gave an update on the buyout program, 2 homes were recently removed from the Little La Crosse river floodplain off of Jamison road. Ron L. discussed county crossing inventory moving forward and funding available to hire one, possible two interns for the summer. A Monroe Count Climate Change assessment is moving forward coordinated by Fred Clark with Green Fire. Fred has partnered with various professional expertise that will dedicate time and effort to this 2021 endeavor in Monroe County.
- Monroe County Manure Storage Ordinance Held first planning meeting February 24th with the Monroe County Ag-Advisory team along with Vernon County participants.  - February 23 Met with Town of Portland Planning Commission to answer questions about process for Comprehensive Plan Update, amending a site permit ordinance, and enacting a nuisance ordinance.
 - Assisted Town of Wellington with data requests for their Comprehensive Plan update.
- FEMA/DNR/Couleecap Voluntary Buyouts: Coordinated with Alison, FEMA, Couleecap, and DNR to administer voluntary buyout project. Demolition contracts were awarded to two contractors to demolish the three properties that were acquired in late January. The demolition and clearing of the properties are on track to be completed well before project deadline of March 31. On February 10, the Town of Leon entered an MOU with the County to work together on the acquisition and demolition of 2 more properties using FEMA and DNR grant funding. We are in the process of acquiring the next three properties (2 in the Town of Leon and 1 in the Town of Portland). Demolition for those properties will be planned for May. I am also coordinating with La Crosse County and Couleecap on 2 properties (Town of Sparta and Town of Leon) to ensure that properties are dedicated to Monroe County.
