Completed Application

 Applications can be picked up at the Clerk of Court's Office or downloaded at

http://travel.state.gov

- Applications must be typed or written in **Black Ink** on 2 separate pages.
- Do not sign the application until you are in front of an acceptance agent.

Passport Photo

 The Clerk of Court's Office does not take photos. Walmart and Walgreens in Sparta offer passport photo services.

Proof of Citizenship (will be sent in with application and returned to you)

- Previous Passport, or
- Certified Birth Certificate and one (1) copy, or Birth Certificates must have authorized seal of the registrar's office. (Hospital Certificate's of Birth are not acceptable)
- Certificate of Naturalization, along with one (1) copy.

Previous Passport

- If you have been issued a passport previously, you must submit it with your application, or
- Complete a Statement Regarding A Lost or Stolen Passport Form (DS-64)

Photo Identification

- Valid Driver's License, or
- State Issued ID Card, or
- Passport, or
- Military ID

Checks or Money Orders

- We send applications through the mail.
- o Credit or Debit cards are not accepted.
- Check with Clerk of Courts or http://travel.state.gov for current costs

Children under 18 years of age with a previous passport must submit their birth certificate and most recent passport.

Children 16-17 Years of Age With Valid I.D.

- Must be accompanied by at least one parent, or
- Show parental consent by:
 - Listing parent as their emergency contact, or
 - Use a parents check

Children Under 16 Years of Age

- Both parents must accompany the child and bring photo I.D., or
- One parent may accompany the child and submit a Statement of Consent Form (DS-3053) completed by the absent parent along with a copy of the front and back of the absent parents photo I.D., or
- One parent may accompany the child and submit documentation showing sole legal custody.

RENEWALS-Application is sent directly to the Passport Center by you

 Renewal Form DS-82 can be picked up at the Clerk of Court's Office or downloaded at

http://travel.state.gov

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR RENEWAL IF:

- o you can you submit your most recent passport card or book
- you were at least 16 years of age when your most recent card/book was issued
- o your most recent card/book was issued less than 15 years ago
- your name is the same now as it appears on your most recent card/book or you can submit proper documentation to reflect your name change
