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# RESOLUTION No. 07s-21-01

## APPROVING PURDUE PHARMA BANKRUPTCY SETTLEMENT PLAN IN REGARDS TO OPIOID LAWSUIT

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Board of Supervisors, in Resolution 11-17-03, determined it to be in the best interest of the county, its citizens, residents, visitors and taxpayers to join with other counties in and outside Wisconsin to engage attorneys to pursue the claims against certain of the opioid manufacturers, and to faithfully participate in the pursuit of the claims and directed all county personnel to cooperate with and assist with the county's participation; and

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WHEREAS, the Monroe County Board of Supervisors, in Resolution 11a-19-05, confirmed it wanted the county to remain a member of the Negotiation Class in In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation, MDL 2804 (N.E. Ohio), for purposes of negotiating a settlement of all claims and issues in the litigation.

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WHEREAS, Crueger Dickinson, LLC, class action attorneys for the county, have presented information on the \$5 billion settlement in the Purdue Pharma bankruptcy plan negotiated by the Plaintiff's Executive Committee; and

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WHEREAS, the involved plaintiff municipalities are to consider the Plan and determine if they will confirm the plan or not; and

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WHEREAS, the Monroe County Board of Supervisors has considered the Plan and the alternative of engaging in further expensive litigation that may take years to reach a favorable judgment, as well as the factors that complicate collection on those judgments because many of the assets of the Sackler Families are in various family trusts located in foreign countries; and that while that litigation continues, local government and other public creditors will have received no resources that can be put to immediate use to abate the ongoing problems under this negotiated Plan.

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NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Monroe County Board of Supervisors does confirm its support of the in the Purdue Pharma bankruptcy settlement plan and authorizes the County Administrator and/or County Board Chairman to act in accordance with this confirmation.
