Highlighted Projects and Activities by Jarrod Roll, Hannah Scholze, and Volunteers

Agriculture Extension Agent: Bill Halfman

Agriculture Program Highlights November 6, 2021 through December 3, 2021

The Ag Agent conducted Beef Quality Assurance workshops on November 9, 16th, and December 3rd. There were approximately 94 people at the three locations. There are three more workshops coming up in the next two months. The Ag Agent serves as one of the state co-coordinators for BQA.

The Ag Agents in Vernon, La Crosse and Monroe began planning a Heart of the Farm program that is going to have a focus on direct marketing to consumers. The date and location is being worked out and will be in Feb or March.

The Ag Agent and his Buffalo County counterpart have been working with the Ho-Chunk Tribe to help them re-visit getting an Agriculture Division organized. They are assisting with helping them to with conducting a strategic planning session.

The Ag Agent along with two state specialists helped two of the students from Cashton High School with data analysis and interpretation on their Junior Science and Humanity projects.

Working out the details and preparing for upcoming winter workshops and presentations has also been a priority over the past month. Especially for the Driftless Region Beef Conference, the Beef x Dairy Webinar series, and the cattle feeders workshops.

The annual Crop Pest Management Updates for Agronomy professionals were held via webinar on two different days this year. The Soil, Water and Nutrient Management series and Agronomy Updates for Agronomy Professionals will also be held virtually. In the past these were held at several locations around the state, with Sparta being the site for one of the stops for each of them.

Agents 4 Change

The Agents 4 Change will be presenting the tobacco/vaping workshop to the Cashton 5th grade on December 21. All 5th graders will get an Escape the Vape Room experience and the tobacco lungs demonstration. The group will also be working to present in Sparta in the new year. The Alcohol program will be done for 6th grade in the spring of 2022.

2021 Monroe County 4-H Plat Book

Slowed down but still moving.

Jr. Leaders

The Jr. Leaders will meet on December 4 before working at the lights. They will elect officers, plan Clover College and make plans for the summer trip. The group has designed a new tee-shirt and will hopefully have them by Christmas.

National 4-H Agents' Conference

The Agent attended the weeklong event from November 15-November 19. There was much information to be gained. The agent will be bringing several ideas learning at the conference to the Monroe County 4-H program. The Agent also received his Achievement in Service Award for the work done in Monroe County in the past 8 years.

KITS (Kids Interested in Trying Stuff)

The Agent and Vicky had a tremendous response to the 2021-2022 KITS roll out. There are 47 youth from 24 families receiving KITS this year. That is a lot of fun learning about different project areas. KITS for December is decorating cookies. Some ideas we are working on are a STEM Project looking at light and kaleidoscopes. (If you have toilet paper or paper towel rolls, we'd happily use them.) The other is a raw wool project to bring in our large animal species. We are also looking for ideas if you want to share. We have about \$2.50 per project per kid to purchase the materials.

Super Fun Project Day

The first of what is hoped to be quarterly Super Fun Project Days is scheduled for December 30. The plan is between the holidays just when mom and dad start praying for school to start again, they can have a fun 4-H day. Projects to choose from will be quilting, leather craft, foods, ceramics, and wooden flower crafts. It should be a super fun day.

Club Leadership Townhall

The Agent held the Club Leadership Townhall on December 4. This training for all volunteers, club officers and high school youth will run from 10am to 3pm out at the Abbey. The main topic on the agenda for the 5-hour meeting is Youth/Adult Partnerships. This discussion is multifaceted. Discussion will look at what kids need from leaders to feel ownership in 4-H and what leaders need from Youth to make giving them power work. We will also look at what research says both parties get from engaging in strong partnerships between these two groups. There will also be time built into the meeting for clubs to plan and build a plan for making a strong partnership in their club.

Shooting Sports

The Shooting Sports Committee has been planning the 2022 season. The plan is to have a winter session of archery and air rifle in Tomah and a spring session for both again in Sparta. There are over sixty youth signed up for these 2 disciplines. There will be summer practice for shotgun and .22 rifle as well for the twenty-four youth signed up for those disciplines. The committee has also raised funds to purchase a full sized 24' trailer and are outfitting it with shelves and storage for the equipment to make the project more mobile. There are also plans for a demonstration of the shooting sports at the 2022 Monroe County Fair.

LCD Business:

- Administrative Assistant Position Jennifer Diamond started on November 17th.
- <u>Farmland Preservation Program</u> Flyer was sent out by DATCP promoting the on-going signup in the two AEA's. First flyer was sent to Portland Township. Receiving many calls of interest and following up with visits and applications.
- Climate Change Task Force The Monroe County Climate Readiness and Rural Economic Opportunity
 Assessment team held two Listening sessions (Cashton & Sparta) on December 1st. Public participation
 was good in Cashton and weak in Sparta, conversations revolved around the information presented and
 future recommendations. December monthly meeting featured a presentation by Bobbi Jo Fisher
 (WDNR) on Stream Crossing assessment that was conducted this past summer in Monroe County. Home
 buyout program, weather monitoring stations and the 2022 plans were discussed.
- Tree Sale Program Number of trees sold as of November 1st 1,575 or \$1,681.
- Angelo Dam Working with DNR/WWTC on water quality monitoring as part of the hydro-dam requirements. Met with Rep Oldenberg on dredging the pond.
- <u>CWD Task Force</u> CWD sampling sites, dumpsters, and venison donation locations were utilized over the 9 day gun season by Monroe County hunters. Some of the sites will stay available through the ML, Antlerless season and the holiday hunt.
- <u>Land Stewardship Awards</u> Planning committee met on December 2, due to the COVID pandemic they decided to move the banquet into late June and hold the banquet at Justin-Trails farm to provide participant an open venue facility. Plan to meet with Donna Justin and work out the details.
- <u>UWSP and Golden Sands Forestry Demo</u> Working with UW-Stevens Point forestry professor-Mike Demchik and his students on a forestry project in Tri-Creek. Students will create a harvest plan with wildlife management focus and mark the timber in 2022. Chad and I will have to setup bids/sale to carry out plan. We also have an area of ash timber that we need to harvest and sell this winter because of emerald ash borer disease has set in.
- <u>County Farm & Tri-Creek CREP</u> DATCP working on converting the existing CREP easement to SWRM
 CREP equivalent easement once State FSA terminates the agreement. Need to complete this transaction
 by the end of December.

- <u>FEMA/DNR/Couleecap Voluntary Buyouts:</u> Coordinated with Alison, FEMA, Couleecap, and DNR to administer voluntary buyout project of 8 properties along the Little La Crosse River in the Towns of Sparta, Leon, and Portland. All 8 properties have been acquired and demolitions have been completed, returning approximately 18 acres to open space. The following items need to be completed:
 - <u>FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program</u> Cooperate with FEMA to complete project closeout. Final reimbursements and reports have been submitted. We are waiting on final project approval and reimbursement adjustment for an ICC (Increased Cost of Compliance) claim.
 - <u>DNR Municipal Flood Control Grant</u> Final reports and reimbursement requests have been prepared and will be submitted after FEMA reimbursement adjustment is completed.
 - Open Space Management Plan A long term open space management plan will be developed and recommendations for ownership and maintenance will be determined.

• Grant Opportunities:

O DNR Wisconsin Assessment Monies (WAM) – Monroe County has been awarded Wisconsin Assessment Monies for brownfield sites located along a railroad corridor within the City of Sparta. A consultant has been selected by the DNR to complete an environmental assessment. Site visits and fieldwork dates will be coordinated with the program manager and consultant.
