ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION III OF THE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTE ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BYRON

The Town Board of the Town of Byron do hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section III of the All-Terrain Vehicle and Utility Terrain Vehicle Route Ordinance dated July 21, 2014 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The following routes are designated all-terrain vehicle and utility terrain vehicle routes in the Town:

- 1. All Town Roads as marked for ATV use with visible signage. ATV routes will be marked at the beginning point with additional directional arrows to show the continuation of the ATV routes.
- 2. State Highway 173 from Highway "G" to Downy Avenue (Approximately 400"). This shall be designated as a local ordinance authorizing the use of all-terrain vehicles and utility terrain vehicles across the Highway 173 Railroad crossing and across the Highway 173 North Branch Brandy Creek Bridge crossing, all pursuant to Section 22.33(4)(d) 3.a. or b., Wis. Stats., and pursuant to Section 22.33 (11)(am)3. Any such person using these crossings shall do all of the following:
 - a. Cross the bridge in the most direct manner practicable and at a place where no obstruction prevents a quick and safe crossing.
 - b. Stay as far to the right of the roadway or shoulder as practicable.
 - c. Stop the vehicle prior to the crossing.
 - d. Yield the right-of-way to other vehicles, pedestrians, and electric personal assistive mobility devices using the roadway or shoulder.
 - e. Exit the highway as quickly and safely as practicable after crossing the bridge.

SECTION TWO: All ordinances in conflict with the foregoing are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
