ORDINANCE No. 08-1-14

The Village Board of the Village of Norwalk do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 08-1-14 is created:

All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV)/Utility Terrain Vehicles (UTV)

- A. <u>Definition</u>: The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to all terrain vehicles (ATV) and utility terrain vehicles (UTV) as defined in Wisconsin Statutes, Section 23.33.
- B. Statutory Authority: Routes of travel for all terrain vehicles and utility terrain vehicles are created pursuant to the Village authority authorized by Wisconsin Statute Section 23.33 (8)(b) and (c).
- C. Routes Designated: No person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle or utility terrain vehicle on any Village street except upon routes and trails designated and marked by official signs posted by Village official(s). All Village streets have approved routes and trails when official sign is posted only. When the sign is down the route and trail has been suspended. The Village streets are to include but not limited to:
 - Wisconsin St.
 - Roosevelt
 - South Water St.
 - Mill St.
 - High St.
 - Lincoln St.
 - Railroad St.
 - Church St.
 - Center St.
 - Pete's Lane
 - West St.
 - North St.
 - Muehlenkamp Rd.
 - S McGary St.
 - South St.
 - Lasso Ave

- Hettman St
- Dewey St.
 - Hill St.
- Lariat Ave.
- Cty. Hwy U
- Cty. Hwy T
- 400-700 Main St.
 - McKinley St.
 - Leather Ave.
- The Village of Norwalk designates State Highway 71 from County Highway U to Property address
 of 18607 State Hwy 71, approximately 350 ft. southeast on St. Hwy. 71, as an ATV/UTV route
 under Wisconsin Statute Section 23.33(4)(d)3.b. and 23.33(11)(am)3.
 - The village of Norwalk Designates State Highway 71 from North Street to County Highway T, approximately ½ mile north on St. Hwy. 71, as an ATV/UTV route under Wisconsin Statute Section 23.33(4)(d)3.b. and 23.33(11)(am)3.
- D. Conditions and Restrictions: As a condition and restriction for the use of the designated
 - 1. All operators shall observe posted roadway speed limits.
 - 2. All operators shall ride/drive single file.
 - 3. Operators shall comply with all rules of the road and provisions of Chapter 23 of Wisconsin Statutes.
 - 4. Markers/Signs to be obeyed. All operators shall obey all route or trail signs, markers or limited erected in accordance with this Section.
 - 5. Declaring Trails Open/Closed. The Village Board shall have the power to declare the routes and trail either open or closed, or any portion thereof as conditions warrant.
- E. <u>Penalties</u>: Wisconsin State Statute Section 23.33(13) (a) is adopted by reference, as amended.

Section 2: All Ordinances in conflict with the foregoing are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect of passage and publication.
