- Pre-construction meeting for CTH U Bridge in Norwalk May 1, 2023. Project to begin May 15, 2023. Contractor has 60 working days to complete the project.
- CTH PP Bridge will not begin until fall.
- Attended pre-construction meeting for I94 Tomah to Camp Douglas last week.
- Hwy 21 from Tomah (near Ocean Spray) to Juneau County line will be resurfaced this summer.
- Material from asphalt milling will be stockpiled at the Sparta corporation yard.
- Conducted a field review of bridge projects that have been proposed.
- Continued design of CTH ET still projected for next year. Federal funding is finite, balance will need to be covered by department.
- Intersection of US 12 and CTH ET scheduled summer 2023.
- Prep work for CTH I east of Cataract has begun. Will be July or August before contractor comes in to do work.
- Executed DMA funding agreement for construction of new salt shed. The bid has been advertised in the La Crosse Tribune and Monroe County Herald. Bids to open April 27.
