Derek Pierce, Facilities and Property Director provided a summary of Monroe County Buildings. Tina Osterberg, County Administrator provided building consolidation and County Highway B property options; department space needs; estimated square footage needs; maintenance building expenditure summary, maintenance utility estimates and maintenance utility comparisons. Discussion. Motion by Supervisor Kuhn second by Supervisor Zebell to recommend consolidation of offices with a new building located at the Administration Center block downtown by proceeding to explore costs. Discussion. All 15 Supervisors voted yes.

Motion to return to the board meeting and adjourn by Supervisor Rogalla second by Supervisor Kuhn at 7:51 p.m. All Supervisors present voted yes.
