OUR SERVICE

The Monroe County Health Department is able to administer **free** immunizations to adults and children if they meet at least one of the following criteria:


- Medicaid eligible OR enrolled
- No insurance
- American Indian/Alaskan Native
- Under-insured (health insurance does not cover the cost of vaccines or only selected vaccines)
