## <u>Defendant's Conviction History For Drug Charges (all criteria must be met for further screening)</u>

\*A "prior conviction" is defined as a prior criminal conviction in any national court of jurisdiction within the last five (5) years. One (1) prior conviction is sufficient, but dismissed/read in (DRI) charges are not considered. The five (5) year exclusionary period is calculated from the date of the pending charge to a date five (5) years prior, excluding any time the applicant spent in custody during that period. If multiple charges are pending, the five (5) year exclusionary period shall be calculated from the date of the earliest pending charge
