Budget Review:

DA, Clerk of Courts, Justice Dept, Medical Examiner, Circuit Court, Dispatch, Sheriff's Dept. Committee reviewed budgets, and had no issues.

Agenda went to County Clerk, was posted at County Clerk's Office, Justice Center, and was published in the newspaper.

Medical Examiner:

Monthly Activities/Caseload Reports: 33 cases in March, 103 cases year to date. Compared to 2019 it is the same within a couple of cases.

Justice Department:

Line Item Transfer: To move \$2,000.00 from Equipment Monitoring -\$1,750.00 to Office Supplies, and \$250.00 to Postage due to Covid 19 costs and purchases.

**Steele moved to approve, Second by Vinslauski. Motion carried (5-0)**

Justice Program Report: 7 participants in Drug Court, adding Mental/AODA Drug Court starting on 4/16/2020.

SHERIFF: Budget Adjustment: \$19,291.00 from squad trade ins to Pischke. This is excess monies from those trade-ins and was previously approved by the County Board to use toward a 3<sup>rd</sup> transport vehicle. Asking that monies be placed in Non-Lapsing Sheriff Fund in order to purchase a vehicle when time allows following the current pandemic.

**Sherwood moved to approve, Second by Vinslauski. Motion carried (5-0)**

Munis: Zero Updates

Monthly Activities/Case Load Reports: Reduced cases due to Covid 19, lowering risk to prevent contracting virus. Population in jail is at 51 at this time. Jail population down due to Covid 19.
