Be it remembered that on the 6th & 7th of May 1858 I was
 surveying the $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec: 19. 17. 44
 owned by Martin Flood, and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec: owned by
 D. Tolton, SE of NE & $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE ^{of NW} owned by J. Lutz; the
 SW of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ owned by J. Tiffany and the SE of NW & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
 NE owned by Lewis Tebbelke and proceeded as follows
 to wit continued at the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the North side
 of the Sec: thence the distance from here to the $\frac{1}{4}$
 Stake on the South side was carefully measured and
 found to contain 79 Ch: 52 Links, thence the distance from
 the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the East side to that on the West side was
 found to be 79 Ch: 73 L. the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the Centre of said
 Sec: was then established at equal distance from the
 $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the N & S side and at proportional distance
 from those on the E & West side.

The distance from the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the N side to the NW
 corner of the Sec: was then found to be 79 39 Ch: 92 Links
 and the 8 Stake on this line was established at proportional distance
 from each of them. The distance from the NW corner of
 the Sec: to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the West side contained 40 Ch: 47 L
 and the 8 Stake established at equal distance between them
