

It is remembered that on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1858, I was surveying the NW of N & the NE of NW 1/4 of Sec: 8. 16. 14 by request of the owner of the same Mr. Anthony Behrens and proceeded as follows to wit: Commenced at the NW Sec: Corner of Sec: 8 thence East to the 1/4 Stake on the N side of the Sec: which 1/4 Stake with bearing trees could not be found; thence further East to the NE corner of the Sec: 79 Ch: 62 Links thence the 1/4 Stake on this Line was established at equal distance between the 2 Sec: Corners and also the 8<sup>th</sup> Stake established at equal distance between the 1/4 Stake and the Sec: corner. Thence South from the 1/4 Stake on the North side to that on the South side distance 80 Ch: 28 Links thence the 1/4 Stake on the Centre was found to have been established at the right place by a former Survey. Thence the 8 Stake on the 1/4 Line between the 1/4 Stake on the Centre and that on the N side of the Sec: was established at equal distance between them thence west 49 Chains + 34 1/2 Links thence East from the 8 Stake between the 1/4 Stake on the Centre & that on the N side of the Sec: 19 Ch: 34 1/2 Links thence N to the 8 Stake west from the NE corner of the Sec:

Variation of the magnetic Needle on the N & S Line - and on the E & W Line - 4 Rods Chain was used. The zero corner was adjusted after the Field Notes. During the measurement the topography of the ground was carefully observed. The Chainmen was sworn according to Law

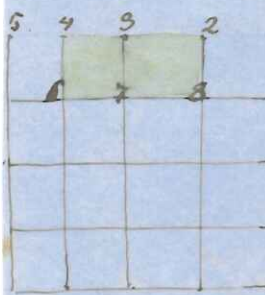
