Be it remembered that on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of  
July 1858 I was surveying a State Road from  
Glenston Jackson Co to Calaret Monroe Co.  
Was according to an act of the Legislature  
of Wis. approved March 13<sup>th</sup> 1858 by order of  
the appointed Commissioner of Calaret  
and Monroe Co & Peleg Merrill of Jackson  
County and proceeded as follows to wit

Determined at a stak feet into the ground  
near the Liberty Pole on Front Street in the  
Village of Wellsville part town of Glenston  
Jackson Co Wis three N 53 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 8Ch 55 Links, three  
S 23 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 1Ch 68 Links to the Trempealeau River, there  
in the same direction across the River 37 Links  
said River are 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet deep, three in the same  
direction 3Ch 84 Links to the Mill race, three in  
the same direction across the Mill race 45 Links  
three in the same direction 38 Ch 22 Links to  
a Grove yard on the East side of the Road three  
S 8 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 20 Ch three in the same direction 20 Ch 75 L  
where it intersect with a former laid out Road  
leading to Black R Falls, three N 82 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 20 Ch 94 L  
to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Line of Section 20, 22, 5 West three S 8 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 20  
<sup>4 Ch 80 L are small stream running with 1/2 foot deep, 4 ft wide</sup> Ch to a Swamp, three in the same direction 6 Ch 32 L, three  
24 Ch 20 L to the NW corner of SW of SW Sec 28, 22, 5 W / 7 Ch: from last  
mentioned point on a Road leading to BR Falls, three in the  
same direction 59 Ch 85 L to the SW corner of Sec 28, 22, 5 W  
three in the same direction 20 Ch to a small stream 2 feet  
wide running <sup>with</sup> through a 4 Rods wide Swamp, three  
in the same direction 8 Ch, three S 18 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 24 Ch 20 Links  
three S 35 $\frac{1}{2}$  W to the top of the Bluff / Merrill Gap / 5 Ch 30.  
three S 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 42 Ch to a stak 4 Rods N of road 8 links on a small  
stream running West 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  foot wide, three S 30 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 20 Ch:  
three S 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 8 Ch to a stream 3 feet wide, and further in  
the same direction to a Black Pine 20" in diameter
