Be it remembered that on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. 1858 I was surveying the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec of NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec: 18 Town 18. Range 1 West by request of the owner of the same Mr. G. H. Douglas and proceeded as follows Commenced at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Stake on the South side of the Sec: thence the distance from here to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Stake on the North side was carefully measured and found to contain 30 Ch: 74 Links. The distance from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Stake on the West side to that on the East side was with a survey made on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April found to contain 30 Ch: 32 Links and the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Stake on the Centre of the Sec: was estab: at equal distances from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Stake on the N & S and also from that one the E & West side. Thence the distance from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Stake on the N side to the SW Corner of the Sec: was carefully
