

Be it remembered that on the 25th day of Nov
 1864 I was surveying a Highway in the town
 of Tomah Missouri Co. Mo. by request of the
 Board of Supervisors of the same of Supervisors Mr H Crane
 and in presence of him and Supervisors Mrs T Dutcher
 & Hill and proceeded as follows to wit Commenced
 at a point on the south $\frac{1}{2}$ Line of Sec: 16. 17. 18 where
 the town of Granddall Road crosses the Line. Said
 point are designated with a Stake with N F N Oak
 6" N 42 W 2 Ch 10 Lumber from the Stake. Thence S 21¹/₂ W ^{12 Ch. 65 L}
 Stake with N F N Oak & S 70 W 159; Thence S 63¹/₂ W 5 Ch 85 ^{5 Ch. 68} to a
 Stake with N F N Oak & S 11¹/₂ W 51 L. Thence S 61 W 8 Ch 87 L to
 a N Oak Marker. Thence S 44¹/₂ W 7 Ch 53 L. to a N Oak 10";
 Thence S 62¹/₂ W 6 Ch 32 L to a Stake with N F N Oak S N 30 W 2¹/₂ L
 where it intersects with the Sec: Line between Sec: 19
 & 20; Thence on the said Sec: Line S 82 W 25 Ch ^{10 L} to the
 $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on said Line; Thence in the same direction on
 said Line 40 Ch to the corner of Sec: 17 18. 19 & 20; Thence
 S 49 W 12 Ch 52 L to a Stake in the middle of the
 town of Redgville Road ~~Stake~~ with N F N Oak 18"
 N 11¹/₂ E 60 L. distance 1¹/₂ Mile 26 Rods 15 L.

It was decided that the road is to be 4 Rods
 wide. The Line of survey to be the center of the
 Road; the topography of the ground and the variation
 of the needle was not taken notice of 4 Rods Chain
 was used.

 and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec: 20. 18. 19 by request of the
 owner of the same Mr J Lebel and proceeded as follows
 to wit. Commenced at the Sec: corner of Sec: 17. 18
 19 20. Thence East to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the Line between Sec:
 17 & 20. distance 39 Ch 71 Lumber Thence the 8 Stake between
 the 2 points was established at equal distances, Thence
 the distance from said $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake to the corner of Sec 16. 17. 20. 21
 was measured and found 39 Ch 88 Lumber and the 8 Stake
 established at equal distance between them; Thence N
