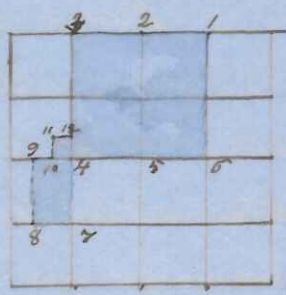


Then the 4 Stake on the Centre of the Sec and also the 8 Stakes was established at equal distance from each other. Then a lot of 5 Acres was divided off from the SE Corner of the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 commenced at the 8 Stake between the 4 Stake on the Centre and that on the W side of the Sec then West 28 Rods to a Stake then N 29 Rods to a Stake then East 28 Rods to a Stake, then S 29 Rods to the place of beginning. Then a Lot of 23 Acres was surveyed from the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec 20. Commenced at the 8 Stake between the 4 Stake on the Centre and that on the West side of the Sec: then South 20 Ch to a Stake then West 40 Rods then N 80 Rods then East to the place of beginning.

Variation on the E & West Lines 11 1/2° and on the N & S Lines 9°. The 900 corners were adjusted after the fieldwork the topography of the ground was taken due notice of during the measuring of the land. The chainman was sworn according to Law 4 Rods chain was used
