It is remembered that on the 12th day of August 1867 I was surveying the N 1/2 of the 32.19 West to locate the 1/4 Section and proceeded as follows to set the 1/4 Section on the line between the 31 & 32 sections according to the field notes from you since the BT was found W Oak 12 N 55 + 8 W 250 links S W Oak 10 S 71 + 4 E 314 links then running from said 1/4 Section East 40 variation 79 Ch 587 Links where a stake was put into the ground with marked S S with B.T. W Oak 12 S 3 W 70 links S W Oak 15 N 25 W 27 Links then further East 79 Ch 579 Links center to the 1/4 Section on the line between the 31 & 32. As measurement it was found that the line was a short line the 1/4 Section on the W to that on the East side 52 links and overran the line between 31 & 32 North from the 1/4 Section 20 Links
