

$\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the W side 40 Ch 27 Links and the distance was divided equally between the different descriptions of Land. 4 Rado Chain was used. The Variation on the N & S line was 7° and on the E & W line 12° . The governments corner was adjusted after the field notes and the 2 chains was removed according to Law.

Be it remembered that on the 14th day of Feb: 1881 I was surveying the $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec: 9 town 19 Range 16th by request of the owner of the same Mr. J. H. Jones and proceeded as follows
Commenced at the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the West side of said Section thence East to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the East side distance 80 Chains 64 Links thence the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake in the centre of said Section was established at equal distances. Thence North from said Centre $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the North side which $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake could not be found. Thence the distance between the NE and NW corner of said Sec: was found to contain 80 Chains and the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake established at equal distance between the two corners and 40 Ch 32 Links North from the Centre $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake the 8 Stakes on said $\frac{1}{4}$ Line was the stab: at equal distance from each of them (20 Ch 16 L) Thence the distance from the $\frac{1}{4}$ Stake on the West side to the NW corner of said Sec: was found to contain 40 Ch 10 Links and the 8 Stakes stab: at equal distance and also the 8 Stakes on the North 8 Line was stab: at equal distance 20 Ch 6 Links Variation of the Needle on the N & S line on the West side 9° and on the $\frac{1}{4}$ Line 8° . and the E & W line 8° .
