Commenced at post at corner of Ses $\frac{26}{35} \frac{25}{36}$ run west 80.47 chs to Sec corner of Ses $\frac{26}{35} \frac{22}{34}$
at 40.23 1/2 chs reestablished 1/4 post and at 60.35 1/4 ch 1/8 stake

Commenced at post corner of Sections 14, 15, 22 & 23 run north to corner of sections 10, 11, 14 & 15 -
Returned and established 1/4 post equidistant from section corners



Bearings trees Burn oak 6 S 44° E 107 Links
Black " 8 S 74° E 140 "
also set 1/8 post at equal distances from section corner and 1/4 corner.

Returned to quarter post below 14 & 15 run west 40 chains and set temporary corner

Commenced at sect corner and run west below ses 15 & 22 found bearing tree to 1/4 post. set post and run north intersecting 1/4 line at 40 chains established this point as the center of sect. Bearing trees Black oak 6 S 33° E 18 Links

Returned post and established 1/8 stake equidistant from 1/4 post and center 1/4 post.

Bearing trees. Red oak 8 S 25° W 18 Links
White oak 6 S 50° W 37
