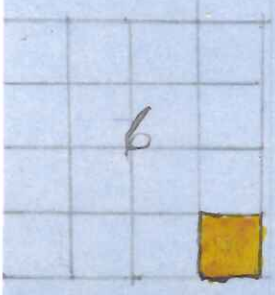

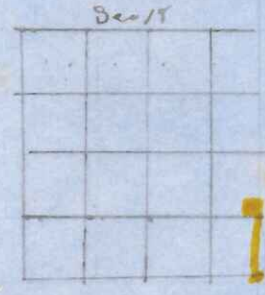

Returned to 1/8 post West of point of commencement and run North intersected 1/4 line at post, returning established 1/8 post at equal distances from section corner and 1/4 corner Made B.P. Wilton 8 7 16 W 88 1/2 Links
Thence from 1/8 post Variation 6° E to 1/8 post intersecting 1/4 line 8 inches north of post

Thence West 196 feet to iron pin in center of Normal & Summit highway B.P.
