Located the N. and S ¼ line of Sec 2, Town 16, 2° W. by request of Board of Supervisors of said Town and proceeded as follows: Commenced at supposed corner of Sec 2, 3, 10 and 11 thence north on sec line between sec 2 + 3. Variation 5° 15' E

Intersected at 78.94 chs. thence east on Town line to ¼ post on North side of Sec 2 found B. P. White oak, now 2 ft in diameter. Thence N 85° W. 28 Links to ¼ post. Returned to supposed corner of Sec 1, 2, 11 + 12. found original B. P. Burr Oak 20 in in diameter S 45° W 38 Links. In setting post uncovered Iron pin and a wood stake along side, in driving stake struck pin and drove stake on N side of pin. Made a new B. P. Burr Oak 18 S 28° 45' W 62 Links - Thence West on sec line between Sec 2 and 11, at 39.95 chains set temporary ¼ post, this being a lot corner, thence to supposed corner of Sec 2, 3, 10 + 11 B. P. tree being destroyed, we proceeded West to ¼ post on Sec line between sec 5 + 8. All corners between the S E corner of Sec 2 and the ¼ post between sec 5 + 8 being lot corners. Set post for ¼ corner from B. P. White oak 18 in. in diameter marked in field notes S 70° E 71 Links should be N 70° W 71 Links. Returned to temporary ¼ post on S line of Sec 2 and set permanent at its proportionate distance and made B. P. as follows: Cherry Tree S 25° W 50 Links

Burr Oak 8 in N 15° W 80 " Thence North on ¼ line from ¼ post to ¼ post. At 40 chs set temporary ¼ corner post and intersected Town Line at 78.37 chs. 40 inches West of post.

South corner set by center ¼ post its proper proportion to the East Chainmen
