

The corner of Sections 35 and 36 of the Town of Milton and
 and 1 and 2 of the Town of Wellington being a lost corner
 I have this day located said corner and proceeded as follows:
 Commenced at corner of town at SE corner of Sec 36. thence West
 on Town line 80 chains and set temporary corner, then from the
 known corner of sections 25 26, 35 & 36 south 80 chains intersecting
 Town line at temporary corner. Made corner by setting old cooking
 in the road, no bearings run. H. La Rue

Surveyed in the presence of the Supervisors of the Town
 of Adams, acting as Pinner Viewers, the line from the $\frac{1}{4}$ post
 on the South side of Section Eleven to corner of sections
 10, 11, 14 & 15. Found $\frac{1}{4}$ corner marked by a stone set even
 with the surface, one foot bearing still standing, also
 the section corner was marked by a buried stone, one
 bearing tree still standing and a marked stone, marked B & C
 placed where the other bearing stood
 & distant from corner a large heavy stone marked
 J & was buried in the earth with marked stone S. 45 E 20 chains
 also another S 45 E 10 chains Survey made Sep 24 1900
 Recorded Nov 1st 1900
