 Monroe County) SS on oath says I have lived in Monroe
 Village of Kendall County Wisconsin about 28 years I
 at one time owned a farm in sec
 tion 23 Town of Wellington in said County & State
 sometime about the year 1874 a S. Pughall was en
 gaged in surveying in my neighborhood including
 part of section 23 I was interested in survey and
 accompanied the party at work when a stake was
 to be placed at the NE corner of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of
 sec 23 as it was also the SE corner of the SE 1/4 of the
 SW 1/4 of section 14 I was directed by said Surveyor
 Pughall exactly where to place and did at that time
 and moment drive a piece of Iron down as a
 quarter stake as also I drove a nail of Iron down
 down by a large soft Maple tree which known as
 a witness tree at this bearing mark of the govern
 ment Survey and for many years stood and was
