J J Jerdee, W S Reynolds and  
L Aphern being first duly sworn on oath hereby State  
that they are residents of Monroe Co Wis and their post  
office addresses are Tomah Monroe Co Wis that they  
were present and witnessed the survey by Charles Crawford  
in the month of April or May 1899 of land in section  
thirty one (31) town 18 R 1 East that they started the  
survey at the South west corner of the South East 1/4 of  
North West 1/4 31.18.1 E running thence East on the  
south line of said 40 acres about 105 rods striking  
the South East corner of said 40 acres thence they  
run North 80 rods striking the North West corner of  
the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 31-18-1 E thence they run still  
North 80 rods striking the North West corner of the NE 1/4  
of NW 1/4 31-18-1 E thence they run East on the  
North line of sec 31, 80 rods striking the North East  
corner of the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 31-18-1 E  
that they found by field notes as a witness tree  
to said corner a white pine tree 10 in. in diameter  
but they found only the stump of the tree with the  
mark upon it  
the tree having been cut above the mark, that said  
witness tree was between 6 or 8 feet in a south east  
direction from said corner that the above named  
surveyor placed a stone at said North East corner  
of the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 31-18-1 E and the above  
named affiants witnessed the placing of the stone  
at this corner
