> A Three (3) rod wide road with the center line of which is described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the South line of Eldora Avenue, approximately 100 feet Northeasterly from road, generally Northwesterly, as the point of beginning; Thence South 800 feet; Thence Southwest 500 feet; Thence East 200 feet; All in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE% of NE%), Section 14, Township 15 North, Range 4 West, Monroe County, Wisconsin.

The undersigned, Supervisors of said Town, did, on the 16th day of July, 1981, at 1:30 P. M., meet at the location of said proposed highway (on the Richard MIsna premises), being the time and place fixed for said meeting on said Notice, and being satisfied by affidavit that the Notices required pursuant to law had been duly given and posted, we did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway, and did hear all reasons offered for and against the application, and did decide upon the application; And it being our opinion that the public good would thereby be promoted, we did decide to lay out said highway as hereinbefore described.

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Supervisors of said Town, do hereby order and determine that a public highway be, and the same hereby is, laid out as described aforesaid.
