Leon Jan 28 1908.

The town board met at R.R. Williams house during the 27th day of January 1908 for the purpose of surveying the proposed highway in the town of Leon according to petition of Geo Payne and others which was ordered filed by County Judge from the decision of commissioners which were appointed for the same.

The highway was surveyed by County surveyor Fred Holden and layed by Town Board as follows. —

Commencing 36 rods west of the quarter post on the north line of Section 4, thence south 30° East 3.5 rods 4 links; thence $84^{\circ} 30'$ west 46 rods $2\frac{1}{2}$ links. Thence south 6° East 5 rods 14 links through lands of R.R. Williams to iron stake at quarter line. 34 rods west of center part of Section 4, thence south $5^{\circ} 45'$ East 35 rods 22 links; thence south $8^{\circ} 5'$ 46 rods 20 links south of line of N.E. quarter of S.W. quarter of Sec. 4. 22 rods 10 links west of the S.E. corner of above described tract, thence south $8^{\circ} 15'$ East 17 rods 7 links, thence $6^{\circ} 15'$ west 19 rods 4 links; thence south 3° west 15 rods 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ links. thence south $5^{\circ} 30'$ East 28 rods 2 links through S.E. quarter of S.W. quarter of Section 4 to iron stake at on south line of Section 4 21 rods 21 links west of Quarter post, thence south 4° west 3.3 rods 1 link, thence south 7° west 28 rods through N.E.

On the 30th day of December 1907 the under signed, supervisors of the town of Leon, in the county of Monroe, decided against the application to them duly made by L. H. Payne and others, dated on the 7th day of November 1907, to lay out a highway described in such application as follows;—

Commencing at a point on the south line of the town line highway between the towns of Sparta and Leon in Monroe County, Wisconsin, thirty-six (36) rods west of the northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of Section Four (4) Township Sixteen (16) North Range Four (4) West, thence south parallel with the section lines through the lands of Robert Williams to a point on the south line of the said Northwest quarter thirty-six (36) rods west of the center of said Section Four (4); thence southeasterly through the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of said Section Four (4) through the lands of R. Kenyon to a point twenty-two (22) rods west of the southeast corner of said Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of said Section Four (4); thence southeasterly through the Southeast quarter of said Section Four (4) through lands owned by A. D. Thurston to a point on the south line of said Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of said Section Four (4) twenty (20) rods west of the east line of said last described forty; thence southwesterly through the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Nine (9) Township Sixteen (16) North Range Four (4) West through lands owned by C. E. Belden to a point twenty-eight (28) rods west of the southeast corner of said last described forty; thence southwesterly through the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of said Section Nine (9) through lands owned by Clifford Austin to a point eighteen (18) rods east of the southwest corner of said last described forty; thence west adjoining and north of the south line of the South Half of the Northwest quarter of said Section Nine (9) to a point four (4) rods west of the southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of said Section Nine (9);

And afterwards upon an appeal taken by L. H. Payne from the determination so refusing to lay out such highway as aforesaid, commissioners were duly appointed to review said determination, and such proceedings were duly had before them that the same was finally reversed, as appears by their decision on said appeal duly filed in the office of the town clerk of the town of Leon on the 25th day of January 1908.

Now therefore, in conformity with said decision and pursuant to the application before mentioned, it is hereby ordered and determined;

That a highway be and the same is hereby laid out in said town as follows; to wit;—

Commencing 36 rods west of the quarter post on the north line of Section Four (4) Township Sixteen (16) North Range Four (4) West, bearing tree a jack oak 16 inches north 20 degrees 30 minutes west 13 rods

south 4 degrees 30 minutes west 46 rods $22\frac{1}{2}$ links, thence south 6 degrees east 57 rods 14 links through lands of Robert Williams to an iron stake on the quarter line 34 rods west of center part of Section 4, thence south 5 degrees 45 minutes east 35 rods 25 links, thence south 8 degrees 5 minutes 46 rods 20 links to the south line of Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section 4 22 rods 10 links west of the southeast corner of above described tract; thence south 8 degrees 15 minutes east 17 rods 7 links, and thence south 6 degrees 15 minutes west 19 rods 4 links, thence south 3 degrees west 15 rods $18\frac{1}{2}$ links, thence south 5 degrees 30 minutes east 28 rods 2 links through Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter Section 4 to iron stake on the south line of Section 4, 21 rods and 21 links west of the quarter post, thence south 4 degrees 21 rods 1 link, thence south 7 degrees west 28 rods through the northwest 53 rods to a point on the east quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Nine (9) to a point on the south line of above described tract 28 rods 7 links west of the southeast corner thereof, thence south 71 degrees west 7 rods 15 links, thence south 32 degrees west 12 rods 18 links, thence 17 degrees west 12 rods 7 links, thence south 14 rods 10 links, thence south 6 degrees west 13 rods 5 links, thence south 7 degrees 30 minutes east 14 rods, thence south 23 degrees west 10 rods 22 links, thence south 75 degrees 30 minutes west 12 rods to a point $1\frac{1}{2}$ rods north of the south line of the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Nine (9), thence west parallel with said south line 20 rods 10 links to a point 4 rods west of the southwest corner of the above described tract;

Whereas, upon being satisfied by the affidavit of Mrs. Clara Cole, that she is the owner of real estate within said Town of Wells, described as follows: the South one-half of the Southwest quarter and the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Six, Township Sixteen, North of Range Three West in Monroe County, Wisconsin, and that the same is shut out from all public highways by being surrounded on all sides by real estate belonging to other persons, and that on account of steep, sandy bluffs it is impracticable to lay out a road from said land to a public highway in the Town where said land is situated, to-wit: the Town of Wells, and that it is practicable to lay out a highway from said land in the Town of Wells to a highway in an adjoining Town, to-wit: the Town of Leon, which is Township Sixteen, North of Range Four West in Monroe County, Wisconsin; that the said land of Mrs. Clara Cole is surrounded on all sides by real estate belonging to other persons, namely: Tom Pittinger, E. 
