The following action was taken by the Highway Commission at its meeting on December 2, 1969.

"There was presented a resolution by the Town Board of the Town of Angelo, Monroe County, requesting that jurisdiction over and maintenance responsibility for the following described frontage road be assigned to the Town of Angelo.

"Beginning at a point 50 feet, more or less, south and 300 feet, more or less, east of the southwest corner of Section 17, Township 17 North, Range 3 West, thence north, east and northeast to a point on the north-south one-quarter line of said Section 17, 370 feet, more or less, north of the south one-quarter corner of said Section 17, located on the alignment and on a right of way as delinerated on the map or copy thereof marked "Plat of Right of way Required, Project I-90-1(4)20."

"This change effects an addition of 0.47 mile to the town road system of the Town of Angelo.

"It was moved and seconded that jurisdiction over and maintenance responsibility for this frontage road be transferred to the Town of Angelo, Monroe County, in accordance with the resolution enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Angelo on November 1, 1969. Carried."
